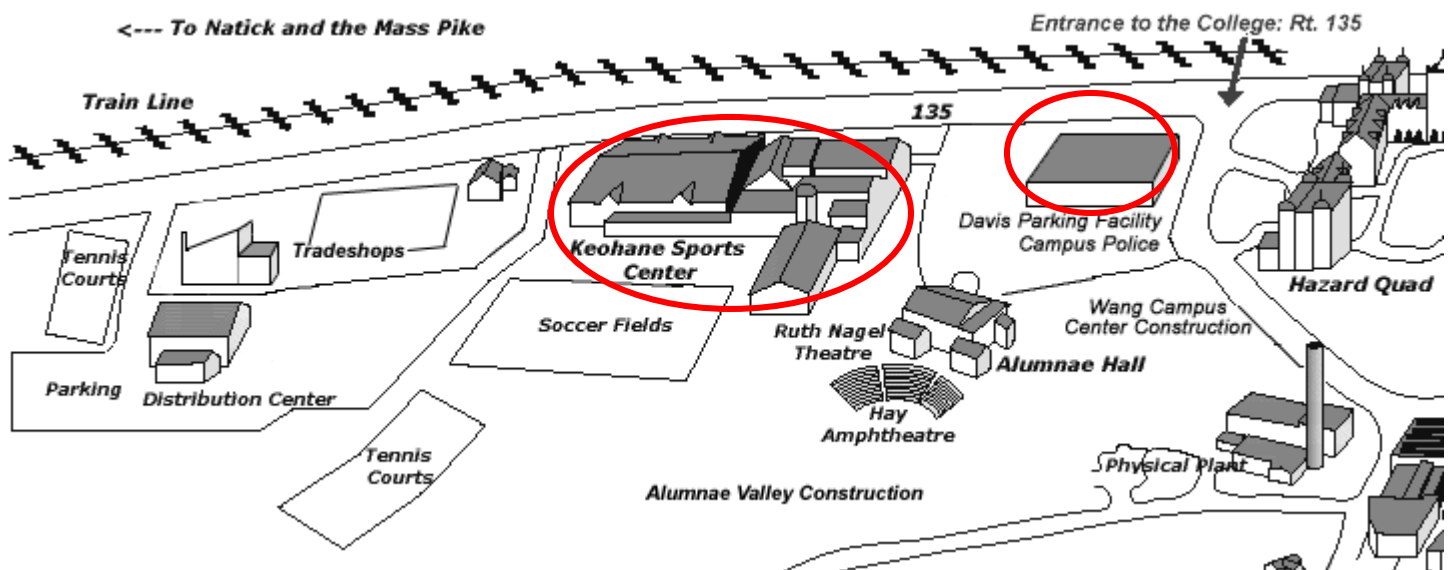

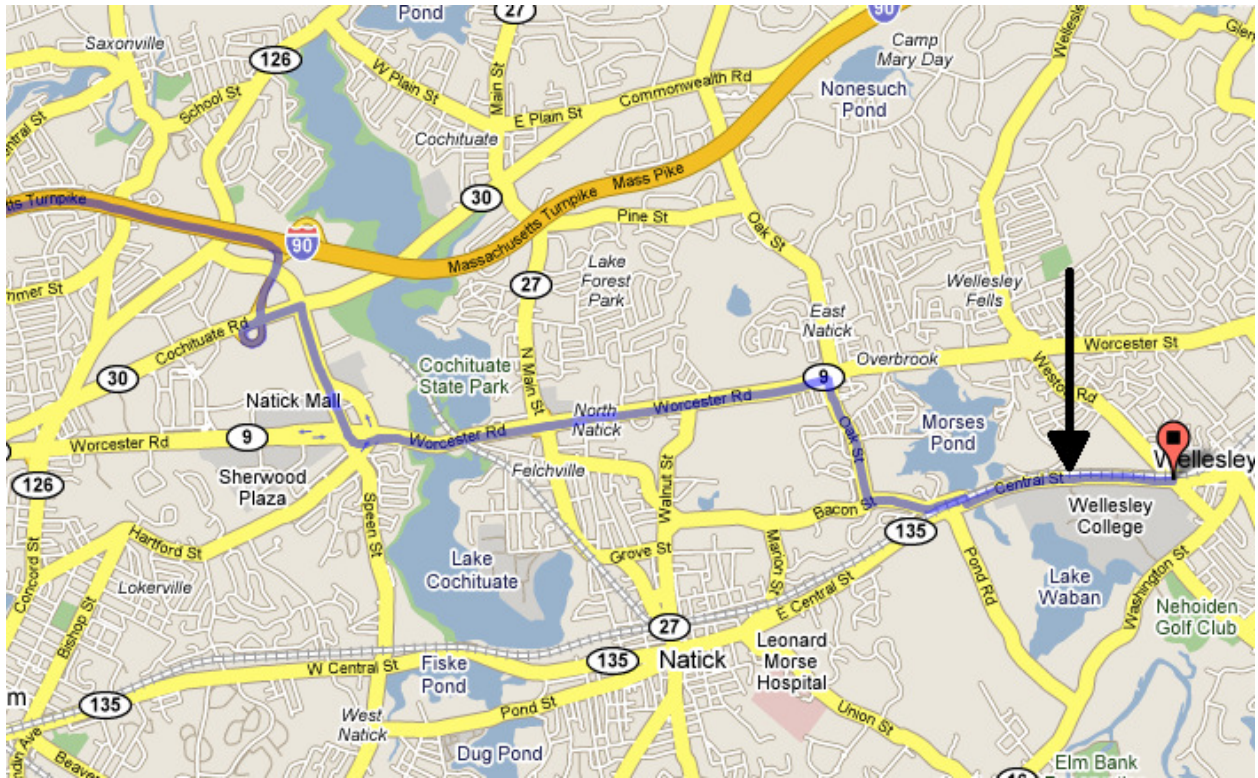
Driving Directions to Wellesley College Campus

From the West

1. Take the Massachusetts Turnpike to Exit 13 (RT 30) to Natick/Framingham.
2. Bear left onto the RT 30 E ramp to Natick/Wellesley (Cochituate Rd).
3. At the first light, turn right onto Speen St.
4. After about ½ mile, bear left onto the RT 9E ramp (Worcester Rd).
5. Travel on RT 9E for 2.2 miles. At the first light, which is immediately after a ScrubaDub car wash, turn right onto Oak St/Rhode Island Ave .
6. Continue on Oak St. for about ½ mile. At the light, turn left onto Bacon St.
7. At the end of Bacon St, turn left onto RT 135/Central St.
8. At the first light, turn right into the Wellesley College main entrance.
9. You may park in the **Davis Parking Facility** immediately to your right after entering campus.



From the East

Take the Massachusetts Turnpike (Interstate 90) to Exit 16 (West Newton). Follow Route 16 West for 4.7 miles to a stoplight (5-way intersection) in the town of Wellesley; go straight on Route 135 (West). At the third traffic light turn left into the main entrance of the College. You may park in the new **Davis Parking Facility** immediately to your right.

From the North

Take Interstate 95 (Route 128) South to Exit 21B (Route 16 West). Follow Route 16 West for 2.9 miles to a stoplight (5-way intersection) in the town of Wellesley; go straight on Route 135 (West). At the third traffic light turn left into the main entrance of the College. You may park in the new **Davis Parking Facility** immediately to your right.

From the South

Take Interstate 95 (Route 128) North to Exit 21B (Route 16 West). Follow Route 16 West for 2.9 miles to a stoplight (5-way intersection) in the town of Wellesley; go straight on Route 135 (West). At the third traffic light turn left into the main entrance of the College. You may park in the new **Davis Parking Facility** immediately to your right.
